Focuses visit according to family's primary concerns			
Takes a thorough developmental history, as follows:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Performs a review of systems that includes questions relevant to developmental concerns 			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Gathers family history relevant to developmental concerns 			
Demonstrates a full pediatric neurologic examination			
Adequately explores family's social context and supports			
Involves the family in determining a treatment/action plan			
INTERPERSONAL AND COMMUNICATION SKILLS			
Communicates information about diagnosis and management in an empathic, respectful, and non-judgmental manner			
Explains to a family the implications of a developmental disability			
Demonstrates active listening			
Appears comfortable and unhurried			
Appropriately gauges parents' level of concern; manages visit time and content accordingly			
Includes child in visit as appropriate for developmental stage			
Recognizes the need for an interpreter; uses interpreter effectively
